Evaluation criteria for short listing and final selection of the candidates

1. Eligibility Criteria:

a. Age Limit: The lower and upper age limits will be 21 years and 45 years respectively, with relaxation of age to SC/ST/OBC and Divyaang candidates as per rules.

b. Essential Educational Qualifications:

M.Sc. degree in Bioinformatics / Biotechnology / Genomics / Biochemistry / Microbiology from a recognized University.

c. Desirable: Candidates having hands on experience on Molecular techniques and Bioinformatics related research will be preferred.

❖ **Essential Educational Qualification : 40 marks**

- Candidates having **first class/first division** (based on percentage/Grade points) in 10th, 10+2, Graduation and Post-graduation will get **10 marks each in the respective category**. (Ex. Candidate having first class/first division in 10th, 12th, Graduation and Post-graduation will get 10+10+10+10 = 40 marks)
- Candidates having **second class / second division** (based on percentage/Grade points) in 10th, 10+2, Graduation and Post-graduation will get **5 marks each in the respective category** (Ex. Candidate having **second class/second division** in 10th, 12th, Graduation and Post-graduation will get 5+5+5+5 = 20 marks)
- Candidates having **pass /third division** (based on percentage/Grade points) in 10th, 10+2, Graduation and Post-graduation will get **3 marks each in the respective category** (Ex. Candidate having **pass /third division** in 10th, 12th, Graduation and Post-graduation will get 3+3+3+3 = 12 marks)

❖ **Desirable Qualifications : 20 marks**

(a) Research / Work Experience : 10 marks

- I. Candidates having 6 months to 1-year research / work / filed experience (relevant to the project / area) will be awarded 3 marks. (Experience less than 6 months will not be counted for allotting marks)
- II. Candidates having >1 year and up to 2 year of research / work / field experience (relevant to the project) will be awarded 6 marks
- III. Candidates having >2 year and up to 3 year of research / work / field experience (relevant to the project) will be awarded 9 marks
- IV. Working experience of more than 3 years of research / work / field experience (relevant to the project) will be awarded 10 marks

(a) Publications: (Research Paper/Review in peer reviewed journals): 10 marks

Peer reviewed journals having the international impact factor (IF)

IF < 0.5	= 0 marks
IF: 0.5-1.0	= 2 marks
IF: 1-2	= 3 marks
IF >2.0	= 5marks

For the calculations of marks, if the candidate is the first author, then full marks, if a co-author, then 75% of the IF will be considered.

❖ **Personal Interview : 40 marks**

Note:

1. Only 10 numbers of candidates will be called for interview who stand sufficiently high in merit on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in respect of educational and desirable qualifications criteria as mentioned under Column I to VI of the Score card.
2. Final selection will be on the basis of candidate's performance in the shortlisting and interview taken together in order of merit.

Tie-breaking Principles

A. For shortlisting the candidates for interview:

- a) In a case where the total marks obtained in r/o column No. I to VI are equal, the candidate senior in age will be ranked higher.
- b) Further, if the candidates are of same age, the candidate securing more total marks in r/o column No. V and VI will be ranked higher.

B. For final selection of the candidates:

- a) In a case of the overall equal marks, the candidate senior in age will be ranked higher.
- b) Further, if the candidates are of same age, the candidate who has obtained higher marks in r/o column No. V while short listing the candidates, will be ranked higher.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING (ONLINE)

 - j. Any other relevant document as desired by the applicant.
