1. (A) COMMON ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TEACHING POSTs:

- (a) Be a citizen of India.
- (b) Be a permanent resident of Balasore District.
- (c) Not have more than one spouse living.
- (d) Must be able to read and write Odia. Any one of the following qualifications will be taken into consideration to ascertain this ability of the candidate.
 - a. He/ she must have passed HSC Exam conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha or an equivalent examination conducted by any other State Board or Central Board (like CBSE, ICSE) with Odia as a Language Subject i.e. First/Second/Third Language.
