Recruitment to the posts of Assistant Professor (Broad Speciality) of Government MCHs in the rank of Group-A under Health & Family Welfare Department, Odisha.

Online applications are invited from the prospective candidates through the proforma application to be made available on the Website of the Commission (http://opsc.gov.in). The link for registration /re- registration and payment of examination fee shall be available from 22.11.2021 to 20.12.2021 (Note: 27.12.2021 is the last date for submission of Registerd Online Application) for recruitment to 381 (Three hundred eighty one) posts of Assistant Professor (Broad Speciality) in Group-A, under the Odisha Medical Education Service cadre for posting in Government MCHs of the State under Health & Family Welfare Department in the Academic Level-12 of ORSP (MCT) Rules, 2019 with usual dearness and other allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time. The posts are temporary and likely to be made permanent.

- (a) In the event of non-availability or availability of insufficient number of eligible women candidate(s) belonging to any particular category, the remaining vacancies will be filled up by male candidate(s) of that category.
- (b) Exchange of reservation between Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe will not be considered in the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable S.C./S.T. candidates.
- (c) The number of vacancy to be filled up on the basis of this recruitment is subject to change by Government without notice, depending upon the exigencies of public service at the discretion of the State Government.
- 3. AGE: A candidate must have attained the age of 21(twenty one) years and must not be above the age of 45 (Forty five) years on the 1st day of January 2021 i.e. he/she must have been born not earlier than 2nd January 1976 and not later than 1st January 2000.

The upper age limit prescribed above shall be relax-able by 5 (five) years for candidates belonging to the categories of Socially & Educationally Backward Classes (S.E.B.C), Scheduled Castes (S.C.), Scheduled Tribes (S.T.) & Women.

Provided that, the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 5(Five) years in case of inservice Doctors serving on ad hoc basis or contractual basis under the Government or Government undertakings, as the case may be.

SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.

Date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

4. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

- (A) In order to be eligible for direct recruitment, a candidate must -
- (i) Have acquired a Post Graduate Degree in the concerned Broad Speciality / Super Speciality or any other equivalent degree or qualification prescribed by the MCI/NMC from time to time.
- (ii) Where the DM/M.Ch. is of two years duration or five years recognized course after MBBS, one year teaching and, or research experience in a recognized institution in the subject of speciality shall be required after obtaining the qualifying degree of DM or M.Ch.
- (iii)Those candidates who have undergone Diplomate National Board training in concerned subject are also eligible for the post of Assistant Professor subject to fulfilling of any other criteria regarding Diplomate National Board, prescribed by MCI/NMC from time to time in force.

5. EXAMINATION FEE: A candidate is required to pay non-refundable and non-adjustable fee of Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five hundred) only. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe of Odisha are exempted from payment of this fee(s).

The candidates are required to make Online payment of applicable Examination Fee(s) through OPSC portal using Debit Card/Credit Card /Net Banking facilities and other financial instruments enlisted in the Payment Page/Gateway of the Odisha Government Treasury Portal. The fee(s) paid shall neither be refunded under any circumstances nor can be adjusted or held in reserve for any other examination or recruitment.

6. <u>METHOD OF SELECTION</u>: The selection of candidates for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor in Broad Speciality will be made as per the guidelines as enumerated in Odisha Medical Education Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021 i.e. on the basis of Written Test from amongst the candidates possessing MD/MS / DM/M.Ch degree in the concerned discipline from MCI / NMC permitted or approved or recognized Medical College and / or any other academic qualification with such additional teaching experience in the subject as may be prescribed by MCI /NMC from time to time in force.

Provided that the recruitment may also be made by way of selection from amongst the Assistant Professors in any other Broad Speciality or Super Speciality subject, having requisite qualification in the concerned Speciality subject to the condition that seniority in the Broad Speciality or Super Speciality in the said discipline as the case may be shall be determine from the date of appointment in the new discipline in accordance with the placement given by the Commission and accepted by the Government.

Provided further that in case of non-availability of MD/MS/DNB candidates in the discipline of Anatomy, Bio-chemistry and Physiology, non-medical teachers possessing M.Sc. degree in concerned subject after MBBS or M.Sc. in Medical Anatomy, Bio-chemistry and Physiology may be appointed to the extent of 15% (fifteen per cent) of the total number of posts in these disciplines (as per prevalent NMC norms).

Written test will be conducted in the following manner:-

- (i) The written test shall be of total 200 marks;
- (ii) The total no. of questions shall be 200 with one mark for each question and will be of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) pattern;
- (iii) There shall be negative marking for wrong answers.
- (iv) For each wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted from the marks awarded for correct answers.
- (v) The qualifying marks in the written examination shall be as decided by the Commission.
- (vi) Duration of examination shall be of 3 hours;
- (vii) Syllabus:-
 - (a) For Medical M.Sc., the syllabus approved by the University for Medical M.Sc. courses.
 - (b) For Broad & Super Speciality, the syllabus shall be MCI approved MD /MS syllabus for Broad Speciality and MCI approved DM / M.Ch syllabus for Super Speciality subjects.

Candidates who are native are resident of Odisha shall be given preference over candidates of other states.

The Commission shall prepare a list of candidates in order of merit on the basis of written test, which shall be equal to the number of advertised vacancies;

Provided that, if two or more candidates secure equal marks, then the candidate securing higher marks in MBBS Examination shall find place above the others in the merit list and in case marks obtained in MBBS Examination is also the same, the candidate older in age shall be placed above the younger.

7. PLACE OF EXAMINATION

The written examination for the post of Assistant Professor Broad Speciality will be held at Cuttack. The programme of examination shall be notified well in advance.

8. OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) The candidate must be a citizen of India;
- (ii) A candidate, who has more than one spouse living, will not be eligible for appointment unless the State Government has exempted his/her case from operation of this limitation for any good and sufficient reasons;
- (iii) Government servants, whether temporary or permanent, are eligible to apply provided that they possess the requisite qualification and are within the prescribed age-limit as provided under Para 3 & 4 of the Advertisement. They must submit No Objection Certificate issued by the competent authority during document verification.
- (iv) **Before appointment**, a candidate must register himself/herself under the Odisha Medical Registration Act, 1961.

If on verification at any stage before or after the examination it is found that a candidate does not fulfil all the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be liable to rejection. Decision of the Commission in regard to eligibility or otherwise of candidate shall be final;
