3) In requesting the employer or the superior officer to issue certificate mentioned in (1) above, it may be pointed out that emergencies such as those that referred to in paragraph (1) are not likely to arise very often. Prospective Home Guards should, therefore, not be scared away nor should their employers, or Superior Officers, hesitated to issue the above certificate for just this reason.
