#### 3.1. Essential Educational (Academic) Qualification : 30 marks

For essential educational qualifications, based on Percentage Marks / OGPA / Grade obtained, in  $10^{th}$ , 10+2, Graduation and Post-Graduation the marks will be awarded as follows:
